## **AIRPORT RELEASES OCTOBER'S STATISTICS**

(Spokane, WA) – Spokane International Airport (GEG) reported that during the month of October, 134,805 passengers boarded planes; a 7.87 percent decrease versus October of 2007's 146,319. Through the ten months of 2008, GEG has handled 2,931,723 total passengers; a 1.64 percent increase over 2007's 2,884,383.

During the month of October, 4,216.2 tons of freight came through GEG in comparison to 4,858.1 tons in 2007; a 13.21 percent decrease. Through October of 2008, 43,812.4 tons of freight has come through GEG in comparison to 45,147.8 tons in 2007; a 2.96 percent decrease.

Felts Field Airport's 7,426 aviation operations during October were a 9.71 percent increase from 2007's 6,769. For 2008, 60,110 aviation operations have been reported at Felts Field; a 4.89 percent decrease versus 2007's 63,203. Felts Field reported no freight was handled during the month of October. Through October 2008, 41.7 tons of freight has been reported at Felts Field; a 33.65 percent decrease from 2007's 62.8 tons.
