## **AIRPORT RELEASES FEBRUARY'S STATISTICS**

(Spokane, WA) – Spokane International Airport (GEG) reported that during the month of February, 133,690 passengers boarded planes; a 13.80 percent increase versus February of 2007's 117,482. Through the first two months of 2008, GEG has handled 525,715 total passengers; a 9.22 percent increase over 2007's 481,346.

During the month of February, 4,352.5 tons of freight and mail came through GEG in comparison to 4,059.6 tons in 2007; a 7.21 percent increase. Through February of 2008, 9,005.5 tons of total cargo was transported through GEG in comparison to 8,341.5 tons in 2007; a 7.96 percent increase.

Felts Field Airport's 3,914 aviation operations during February were a 23.35 percent increase from 2007's 3,173. For 2008, 6,797 aviation operations have been reported at Felts Field; an 8.37 percent increase versus 2007's 6,272. Felts Field also reported 5.8 tons of freight was handled during February; a 16.00 percent increase over 2007's 5.0 tons. Through February 2008, 10.0 tons of freight has been reported at Felts Field; a 2.04 percent increase from 2007's 9.8 tons.
