AIRPORT RELEASES STATISTICS FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY

(Spokane, WA) – Spokane International Airport (GEG) reported that during the month of February, 106,314 passengers boarded planes; a 2.71 percent decrease versus February of 2009's 109,270. Through the first two months of 2010, GEG has handled 441,092 total passengers; a 0.20 percent increase over 2009's 440,230.

During the month of February, 3,529.2 tons of freight came through GEG in comparison to 3,575.7 tons in 2009; a 1.30 percent decrease. Through February of 2010, 7,111.4 tons of freight has come through GEG in comparison to 7,656.5 tons in 2009; a 7.12 percent decrease.

Felts Field Airport reported 4,860 aviation operations during February; a 16.35 percent increase from 2009's 4,177. For 2010, 8,588 aviation operations have been reported at Felts Field; a 16.10 percent increase versus 2009's 7,397. Felts Field also reported 3.7 tons of freight was handled during February; a 17.04 percent decrease over 2009's 4.5 tons. Through February 2010, 7.3 tons of freight has been reported at Felts Field; a 39.95 percent decrease from 2009's 12.2 tons.
