AIRPORT RELEASES MARCH'S STATISTICS

(Spokane, WA) – Spokane International Airport (GEG) reported that during the month of March, 156,083 passengers boarded planes; a 6.28 percent increase versus March of 2007's 146,859. Through the first three months of 2008, GEG has handled 830,836 total passengers; an 8.05 percent increase over 2007's 768,961.

During the month of March, 4,378.2 tons of freight and mail came through GEG in comparison to 4,788.5 tons in 2007; an 8.57 percent decrease. Through March of 2008, 13,383.7 tons of total cargo has come through GEG in comparison to 13,130.1 tons in 2007; a 1.93 percent increase.

Felts Field Airport's 4,559 aviation operations during March were a 25.38 percent decrease from 2007's 6,110. For 2008, 11,356 aviation operations have been reported at Felts Field; an 8.29 percent decrease versus 2007's 12,382. Felts Field also reported 3.6 tons of freight was handled during March; a 30.96 percent decrease over 2007's 5.2 tons. Through March 2008, 13.6 tons of freight has been reported at Felts Field; a 9.40 percent decrease from 2007's 15.0 tons.
