



JOINT PRESS RELEASE

On June 12, 2010, RMA, Inc., d/b/a Spokane Airways, and the Spokane International Airport reached a global resolution of all current and potential litigation arising from the Airport's condemnation of certain property at the Airport to meet line-of-sight requirements for its new Air Traffic Control Tower. The resolution, which is contingent on approval from the Spokane Airport Board as well as the City of Spokane and the County of Spokane, will bring an end to nearly three and one-half years of litigation between RMA and the Airport, and will allow for RMA's continued presence as a fixed-base operator at the Airport. Both parties are pleased to be able to put this difficult chapter in their relationship behind them, and look forward to a successful working relationship in the future.
