PAVING WORK ON OUT-BOUND AIRPORT DRIVE

(Spokane, WA) – Spokane International Airport (GEG) announced asphalt pavement work on approximately one mile of the outbound lanes of Airport Drive from Flint to Spotted Roads.

During the three week construction period, traffic will be limited to one lane. There will be brief intermittent road delays of 5 – 10 minutes while the contractor works in the intersection of outbound Airport Drive and Spotted Road during the project’s second and third weeks of construction. Also during this time, an occasional detour will be established from Spotted Road and inbound Airport Drive to Flint Road. The Airport encourages motorists to drive with caution and to be attentive to construction workers and equipment operating in this area. An overview of the project’s schedule includes:

- Week of August 2, the work will involve patching and crack sealing of the existing pavement.
- Week of August 9, the pavement in the intersection of outbound Airport Drive and Spotted Road will be patched and ground in preparation for paving.
- Week of August 16, the contractor will overlay the existing two lanes of outbound Airport Drive with 2” of asphalt.

The outbound Airport Drive road work was included in the “2010 Miscellaneous Pavement Projects” contract that was awarded to Shamrock Paving of Spokane in the amount of \$600,931.81 at the July 21, 2010 meeting of the Spokane Airport Board. The contract also includes, but is not limited, to patching, crack sealing, and fog sealing of the “original” Concourse C Parking lot and replacing sections of pavement within the Airport Operations Area at the Air Cargo Building and adjacent to the Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting building.
